


2014 IN NUMBERS

Gender and Age of TCF Beneficiaries

8334 (4302 men, 4032 women) active citizens participated in TCF program activities: non-formal education and training on active citizenship and community organizing, conferences, forums and other networking activities, and implementation of community projects. Majority of participants are youth between 15-30 years of age, 2.719 persons.

Main segments are: education and community organizing, financial support to civic initiatives and networking of active communities and citizens in cooperation with the Network of Active Communities Tuzla.

Youth empowerment program offer education to young people engaged in the Youth Bank Boards in 5 above mentioned cities. Through program, TCF financially supports youth associations and groups, and helps networking activities of youth throughout program. Additionally we promote democracy, tolerance and equality among children and youth in cooperation with Smile for Smile Tuzla.


COMMUNITY






Tuzla Community Foundation (TCF) develops programs that promote active citizenship and involvement of youth into community development. Main target groups are: citizens associations and non-formal citizens' groups of active citizens, particularly youth, schools and community centres but also government officials who make crucial decisions about community development. TCF also leads initiatives and convene community discussions on community issues and priorities. Particularly, TCF promotes culture of giving and establish partnership with domestic philanthropists who wants to invest into community development.

TCF supported 35 projects in value of up to 5.000 BAM each: 5 for reconstruction of bridges, 13 reconstructions of houses, 5 water wells, 6 river banks, 5 water drainage pipes, 2 landsliding areas, 1 reconstruction of school.


Support to agriculture 38.036 producers

472 citizens participated in the education about civic engagement, community organizing and project management. 52 of them have attended advanced training on advocacy within community organizing


249 unique beneficiaries of Youth Bank Boards in the age from 14 to 26, took participation in training and workshops on youth leadership and youth organizing, decision making, project management, communication, etc. Participants networed with youth organizations on regular basis.

165 citizens exchanged experiences at Citizens Conference in January 2014; 146 youngsters presented their youth projects at the Youth Conference in December 2014; 300 citizens discussed community issues in their neighbourhoods; 60 representatives of local authority offices and 10 politicians took participation in TCF activities. učestvovalo u aktivnostima FTZ-a.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS OF SUPPORT

"Fight Youth Poverty" Project

"Fight Youth Poverty Project" is implemented in 15 high toristic schools in Bosnia and Herzegovina in cooperation with Kultur kontakt Austria. Teacher and students were attended training in entrepreneurship to improve practical skills for establishment of School Exercise Business in tourism.





Projekat is finances by Rotary Clubs from Austria and Germany, German Rotary Foundation and German Ministry for Economic Development and Cooperation (BMZ). Through this project BMZ approved additional funds for reconstruction of touristic school in Doboj after ther floods.

Tuzla Community Foundation distributed four grants for intitutional development of our strategic partners that work on promotion of democracy, active citizenship and youth involvement in the community development as well as community education.
